

Deutscher Akademischer Austausch Dienst (DAAD) Fellowship-2010

Total number of fellowships offered to ILRI- 5

Nature of Fellowship- three years **PhD**

The initial grant is for one year only- the scholarship can be extended towards the end of the initial grant upon receipt of progress report.

Selection Criteria-

- Age Limit for applicants- 36 years at the date of application
- Only candidates from Sub-Saharan African Countries- Excluding Kenyan nationals are eligible for funding
- Proof of admission (provisional/conditional) at a chosen university is required
- Applications from female candidates encouraged

Financials-

The funding will cover stipend, tuition fees and other costs. Detailed description is as under-

Itemised costs per student per year

University Registration and Tuition Fees	3,000.00
Research and Academic Monitoring (incl. Additional costs for field work, lab facilities, books, thesis, travel costs etc	3,300.00
Stipend (incl. Living Allowance and Accommodation. 500 US-\$ /month for students who will be relocating to ILRI. For students who will be based in their home country the stipend is \$250**	6,000.00 Or 3,000
Medical Insurance	300.00
Total	12,600.00 or 9600

** for students who will be based in their home countries- their work plan must show at least 18 months of work (spread in three years) to be done at ILRI.

Procedure-

ILRI will pre-select applications, then forward these (maximum 15 applications) to DAAD for final approval.

Time Line-

Receive Applications by ILRI - by 20th June
ILRI's internal selection process- by 10th July
Applications/nominations submitted to DAAD- 20th July
