CALL FOR APPLICATION

The “**conseil de fondation**” of the Centre Suisse de Recherches Scientifiques en Côte d'Ivoire (CSRS) wishes to increase the number of graduate students from Swiss universities working in collaboration with the CSRS in West Africa, and it is pleased to announce the first session of its **W Müller Award** to help to finance this collaboration.

The award is open to graduate students (**MSc and PhD**) registered at Swiss universities and planning to conduct their projects (at least in part) in West Africa in close collaboration with a team of the CSRS in one of their research areas. These are: **(i) environment and health, (ii) food security and nutrition, and (iii) biodiversity and conservation.**

The project must be in line with the strategic plan of the CSRS.

The “**conseil de fondation**” will award up to **5'000 CHF per project** from its **W Müller** fonds; in 2016-17 two projects will be funded.

Grants are awarded solely on merit, that is, on the strength of each individual application.

To apply, please send

- A description of the project (maximum 2 pages, written in French)
- A curriculum vitae
- A letter of support of the Swiss supervisor of the student
- A letter of invitation from the collaborator(s) at the CSRS
- The budget of the project

There is no deadline. The applicants will be informed of the decision of the “**conseil de fondation**” after the meeting following the date of application (**the conseil meets twice a year in February and October**).
